MBBS Graduate Entry Course
Do Medicine in 4 Years!!

The College of Medicine, Nursing & Health Sciences (CMNHS) has developed the University Senate approved Graduate entry into the Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) Programme. The Graduate entry course MED602 Modified Problem Based Learning (PBL), will commence for enrolment in Semester 2, 2017.

The basic 6 years degree or educational foundation for a doctor offered by CMNHS is the MBBS programme. This degree incorporates the Basic Sciences: clinical and applied anatomy, functional physiology, microbiology, pathology, pharmacology, radiology; Public Health and Primary Care; and the Clinical Sciences: internal medicine, surgery, psychiatry, paediatrics, ophthalmology, and gynaecology and obstetrics.

The Graduate lateral entry provides an opportunity to those who have a prior Health Science degree, an alternative entry into the MBBS Programme. It requires the completion of the course MED602 in the MBBS year 3. It is an intensive 1 year (2 semesters) course; that is to commence from Semester 2 2017 to Semester 1, 2018. Upon passing MED602, students will then be eligible to join MBBS year 4 in/from semester 2, 2018.

This new course also provides the opportunity to allow candidates who initially decided to enrol in MBBS and become doctors but could not do so because of insufficient study placements.

Minimum Entry Requirements (MER):

The following requirements are for entry into the one year intensive MBBS graduate entry course:

- Completed Bachelor in Pharmacy, Bachelor in Physiotherapy, Bachelor in Medical Imaging, or Bachelor in Medical Laboratory Sciences degree with a minimum GPA of 3.0/5 or equivalent, B or 70%;
- Consistently sound academic records with no repeats or supplementary;
- Obtained previous degree preferably within the last 3 years;
- Satisfactorily passed the rigorous Entrance Exam and Multiple Mini Interviews;
- Satisfactory medical examination report;
- Obtain a Reference of Good Character and Police clearance; and
- All applications will be vetted by the School of Medical Sciences MBBS admission Committee.

**Applicants who graduated from the Fiji National University or Fiji School of Medicine or from any other recognised University before 2013 will have their grades assessed and benchmarked to the equivalent GPA.

Applications close at 4pm on Friday June 16, 2017.
