1	Preliminary Social Science	A pass in Year 11 certificate examination is required for enrolment in the Preliminary Social Science programme or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR).
2	Foundation Social Science	A pass in the Year 12 Examination is required for entry to the programme or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR).
3	Unclassified Studies	The applicant must meet the prerequisites of the course/unit.
4	English as a Second language for Beginners (ESL)	Very basic English
5	Certificate of Proficiency in Business Communications	Completion/participation in ESL Programme
6	Certificate of Proficiency in English as a Second Language	Beginners English

7	Certificate II in Hairdressing & Beauty Therapy	A pass in Year 10 with a pass in English or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR). Mature students who have 2 or more years of industry experience may also be considered.
Certificate III		
8	Certificate III in Aged Care	Successful completion of Year 11 with 200 marks and above including a pass in English or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR). Applicants may also be admitted on the basis of maturity, work experience or prior learning.
9	Certificate III in Child Care	Successful completion of Year 11 with 200 marks and above including a pass in English or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR). Applicants may also be admitted on the basis of maturity, work experience or prior learning.
Certificate IV		
10	Certificate IV in Media & Journalism	A pass in Year 12 including a pass in English with 75% or more or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR).
11	Certificate IV in Graphic Design	A pass in Year 12 with a pass in English or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR). Mature students who have 2 or more years of industry experience may also be considered.
12	Certificate IV in Music	A pass in Year 12 with a pass in English or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR). Mature applicants with musical interest and ability may also be considered.
13	Certificate IV in Screen Printing & Signage	A pass in Year 12 with a pass in English or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR). Mature applicants with 2 or more years of industry experience may also be considered.
14	Certificate IV in Film & Television Production	Successful completion of studies up to Year 12 (12 years of continuous progression), with 50% in English or equivalent. Applicants may also be admitted to Certificate IV in Film & Television program who may not meet the 12 years of continuous progression requirement, but who are able to demonstrate their ability to succeed in programs at these levels on the basis of maturity, work experience, or prior learning.
15	Certificate IV in Sports Science	A pass in the Year 12 Examination or equivalent with 50% scores in English, Mathematics and Biology. Applicants who do not meet the above, may also be admitted if they are able to demonstrate their ability to succeed in programmes at these levels on the basis of maturity, work experience or prior learning.

16	Higher Education Certificate in Early Childhood Education	A 250 pass in Year 13 examination with pass in English and 3 other subjects or mature age entry with experience in early childhood education or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR).

17	Diploma in Media & Journalism	Successful completion of Certificate IV in Media & Journalism programme or 5 years of industry experience or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR).
18	Diploma in Music	Successful completion of Certificate IV in Music or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR).

19	Trade Diploma in Sports Science	Successful completion of Certificate IV in Sports Science. Applicants who do not meet the above, may also be admitted if they are able to demonstrate their ability to succeed in programmes at these levels on the basis of maturity, work experience or prior learning.

20	Bachelor of Education (Primary)	A pass in Year 13 with a total of 250 or more marks in four subjects including 50% in English and Mathematics with Vernacular up to class 8 or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR).
Bachelor of Education (Secondary)		
21	Bachelor of Education (Accounting/Economics)	A pass in Year 13 Examination with a total of 250 or more marks in four subjects including 50% in English, Accounting and Economics or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR).
22	Bachelor of Education (Agricultural Science)	A pass in Year 13 Examination with a total of 250 or more marks in four subjects including 50% in English, Mathematics and two science subjects or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR).
23	Bachelor of Education (Industrial Arts)	A pass in Year 13 Examination with a total of 250 or more marks in four subjects including 50% in English, Mathematics, Technical Drawing and one science subject or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR).
24	Bachelor of Education (Biology/Chemistry)	A pass in Year 13 Examination with a total of 250 or more marks in four subjects including 50% in English, Biology and Chemistry or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR).
25	Bachelor of Education (Mathematics/Physics)	A pass in Year 13 Examination with a total of 250 or more marks in four subjects including 50% in English, Mathematics and Physics or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR).
26	Bachelor of Education (Mathematics/Computer Science)	A pass in Year 13 Examination with a total of 250 or more marks in four subjects including 50% in English, Mathematics and Computer Studies or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR).
27	Bachelor of Education (Mathematics/Information Systems)	A pass in Year 13 Examination with a total of 250 or more marks in four subjects including 50% in English, Mathematics and Computer Studies or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR).
28	Bachelor of Education (Physics/Computer Science)	A pass in Year 13 Examination with a total of 250 or more marks in four subjects including 50% in English, Physics and Computer Studies or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR).

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29	Bachelor of Education (Physics/Information Systems)	A pass in Year 13 Examination with a total of 250 or more marks in four subjects including 50% in English, Physics and Computer Studies or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR).
30	Bachelor of Education (Geography/History)	A pass in Year 13 Examination with a total of 250 or more marks in four subjects including 50% in English, Geography and History or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR).
31	Bachelor of Education (English/Hindi)	A pass in Year 13 Examination with a total of 250 or more marks in four subjects including 50% in English and Hindi or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR).
32	Bachelor of Education (English/iTaukei)	A pass in Year 13 Examination with a total of 250 or more marks in four subjects including 50% in English and iTaukei or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR).
33	Bachelor of Education (English/Geography)	A pass in Year 13 Examination with a total of 250 or more marks in four subjects including 50% in English and Geography or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR).
34	Bachelor of Education (English/History)	A pass in Year 13 Examination with a total of 250 or more marks in four subjects including 50% in English and History or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR).
35	Bachelor of Education (Home Economics)	A pass in Year 13 Examination with a total of 250 or more marks in four subjects including 50% in English and Home Economics or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR).
37	Bachelor of Education (Physical Education/Art & Craft)	A pass in Year 13 Examination with a total of 250 or more marks in four subjects including 50% in English or its equivalent. Other documentary evidence of achievement in one or more PEMAC subjects would be an advantage: Physical Education - Certificate of participation at any level in Athletics and/or other sports. Art & Craft - Certificate in Bandsmanship or Fiji Arts Council Certificate or equivalent. A reference letter from the School Principal and/or other relevant organisations indicating active participation in Physical Education, Music and/or Art & Craft or equivalent as per the University Academic & Student Regulations (UASR).

38	Graduate Certificate in Education	i. Applicants should normally hold an approved first degree (BA, BCom, BSc, BE) or equivalent qualification. ii. Applicants who do not meet i) above, may also be admitted to do the GCED programme if they are able to demonstrate to the School of Education their ability to succeed in programmes at these levels on the basis of their maturity, work experience or prior learning.

39	Postgraduate Diploma in Social Policy	A B+ average in any undergraduate degree. A recognised experience from related work or recognised years at middle management position in any sector

40	Master of Philosophy	The minimum entry requirement for admission to the Master of Philosophy degree programme shall be completion of a Bachelor's degree programme in the subject with a minimum GPA of 3.0 or equivalent. Applicants may also be admitted to the Master of Philosophy degree programme who may not meet the requirement as per above, but who are able to demonstrate their ability to succeed in programmes at these levels on the basis of their maturity, work experience or prior learning. For such students the MPhil is a terminating qualification. The Dean may require such an applicant to sit for any specific or general examination as a prerequisite for any such enrolment, or may restrict enrolment only to certain prescribed courses that must be passed to progress further.
41	Master of Arts in Social Policy	Successful completion of the Postgraduate Diploma with an average of B+ standing will qualify for accession into the Master of Arts in Social Policy Programme. The Master of Arts will be a Research and Thesis only under a supervisor.

42	PhD in Social Policy	Successful completion of the Postgraduate Diploma with an average of B+ standing will qualify for accession into the Master of Arts in Social Policy Programme. The PhD in Social Policy will be a Research and Thesis only under a supervisor.
