Target Audience

It is recommended that individuals wishing to undertake the CILT International Certificate are involved with:

- Contributing to the establishment of activity plans to support logistics operations; and/or
- Supervising and controlling operational activities.

For entry to the International Certificate Candidates are expected to have some prior knowledge of logistics and transport operations and an awareness of the integrated nature of supply chain activities, ideally through their **own work experience and knowledge gained from studying the International Introductory Certificate course**. Applicants who have successfully completed the **CILT International Award in logistics and Transport programme or CILT International Introductory Certificate in Logistics and Transport** can progress onto **CILT International Certificate in logistics and Transport**.

Note:

1. All interested participants are required to enroll before the commencement dates as stated above. Course fee to be **paid in full prior to certificate collection**.
2. All students **must register** with CILT International at the commencement of the programme. Please contact your course coordinator for registration.
3. If you are enrolled for a certain date, you are mandatorily required to complete the course within that date. If you **cannot attend** the course as per the specified date, you are required to **withdraw before** the commencement of the course.
4. Participants are to **follow proper dress code**. No round/v necked t-shirts, slippers, hats allowed. Those who do not follow the proper dress code will not be allowed inside the campus.
5. **Classes begin at 0800 hours unless stated otherwise** by the course coordinator. Late entry to class will not be permitted unless notified earlier to the course coordinator for being late with genuine/ appropriate reason. **Attendance of 100% is mandatory**.
6. The dates for each course may overlap with weekends and public holidays. However, classes are not conducted on weekends and public holidays unless stated otherwise by the course coordinator.
