The candidate should be the minimum age of 18 years while resuming the course. Basic Sea Safety – Operate Small Boats Certificate (3-day course) and have 12 months MSAF approved sea going service.

Have valid medical certificate to work in Deck Department (as per MSAF specified format)

Note:

- 1. All interested participants are to **enrol before the commencement** dates as stated above. Course **fees to be paid in full prior** to certificate collection.
- 2. If you are enrolled for a certain date, you are mandatorily required to complete the course within that date. If you cannot attend the course as per the specified date, you are required to withdraw before the commencement of the course.
