Pre-requisite:

a. SA – The candidate should be the minimum age of 16years while resuming the course.

b. SDSD – The candidate should be the minimum age of 16years while resuming the course and should have approved seagoing service for 6 months.

c. SSO – The candidate should have approved seagoing service for 12 months OR appropriate seagoing services with knowledge of ship's operation.

d. CM – The candidate should have completed Basic Safety Training Certificate prior to taking this course.

Note:

- 1. All interested participants are **required to enrol before the commencement dates** as stated above. Course fee to be paid in full prior to certificate collection.
- 2. If you are enrolled for a certain date, you are mandatorily required to complete the course within that date. If you cannot attend the course as per the specified date, you are required to withdraw before the commencement of the course.
- 3. Participants are to **follow proper dress code**. No round/v necked tshirts, slippers, hats allowed. Those who do not follow proper dress code will not be allowed inside the campus.
- 4. Classes begin at 0800hours unless stated otherwise by the course coordinator. Late entry to class will not be permitted. Attendance at 100% is mandatory.
- 5. The dates for each course may overlap with weekends and public holidays. However, classes are not conducted on weekends and public holidays unless stated otherwise by the course coordinator.
