### Target Audience

Applicants who have successfully completed the **CILT International Award in Logistics and Transport programme** can progress onto CILT International Introductory Certificate in Logistics and Transport.

### Note:

- 1. All interested participants are required to enroll before the commencement dates as stated above. Course fee to be paid in full prior to certificate collection.
- 2. All students must register with CILT International at the commencement of the programme. Please contact your course coordinator for registration.
- 3. If you are enrolled for a certain date, you are mandatorily required to complete the course within that date. If you cannot attend the course as per the specified date, you are required to withdraw before the commencement of the course.
- 4. Participants are to follow proper dress code. No round/v necked t-shirts, slippers, hats allowed. Those who do not follow the proper dress code will not be allowed inside the campus.
- 5. Classes begin at 0800 hours unless stated otherwise by the course coordinator. Late entry to class will not be permitted unless notified earlier to the course coordinator for being late with genuine/ appropriate reason. Attendance of 100% is mandatory.
