Candidates should fulfill the MER for each stage. All units to be completed before enrolling for the next stage. 3. ETH401 & COM402 are not mandatory units for Upgrading students. However, if you plan to graduate with a diploma in future, you will be required to complete the two units as part of the program structure. 4. Candidates are required to bring along their original or certified copy of BC, FRCS Joint Card, or TIN letter with any Valid Photo ID. This is required to update candidate's electronic folder. 5. Candidates are required to submit the previous stage results with the enrolment forms. 6. All candidates are advised to consult the HOD or the Department Administrator in case they wish any form of guidance on program structure. This is for continuing students and new admissions. 7. Classes begin at 0800hours unless stated otherwise by the course coordinator. Late entry to class will not be permitted. Students are to at least meet 75% of attendance. 8. The dates for each course may overlap with weekends and public holidays. However, classes are not conducted on weekends and public holidays unless stated otherwise by the course coordinator. 9.
