- CM – The candidate should have completed Basic Safety Training Certificate prior to taking this course.

NOTE:

- The course will be delivered upon the **minimum number** of intakes is **met**. If the minimum number of intakes for this course is not met, the course may be **deferred** or **cancelled**. - All interested participants **must enroll prior to the course commencement dates** stated above. The **course fee must be paid in full before attending the class**. - If you are enrolled for a certain date, you are **mandatorily required** to complete the course **within the dates**. If you **cannot attend** the course as per the specified date, you are required to **withdraw before the commencement of the course**.
