Prerequisite:

1. The candidate should be the minimum age of 18years while resuming the course.
2. Hold Basic Safety Certificate.
3. Applicants holding Engine Watch Rating Certificate are also applicable to apply for Able Seafarer Engine Course
4. Submit MSAF Approval letter to enroll into Able Seafarer Engine course (based on the seagoing experience).

Note:

1. The course will be delivered upon the **minimum number** of intakes is **met**. If the minimum number of intakes for this course is not met, the course may be **deferred** or **cancelled**. In such cases, applicants will be **notified** via the **PCMS webpage** on the **FNU website**. Students are advised to **regularly check** the **Course Schedules** and/or **Student Notice** sections under the **Student Information** menu on the **PCMS webpage** for updates. For further clarification, contact the Administrator.
2. All interested participants **must enroll prior to the course commencement dates** stated above. The **course fee must be paid in full before attending the class**. Upon **successful completion of the course** and **fulfillment of the certificate issuance requirements**, participants may **collect their certificates**.
3. If you are enrolled for a certain date, you are **mandatorily required** to complete the course **within the dates**. If you **cannot attend** the course as per the specified date, you are required to **withdraw before the commencement of the course**.
4. Participants are to follow a **proper dress code**. No round neck/V neck t-shirts, slippers, hats allowed. Those who do not follow the proper dress code will not be allowed inside the campus.
5. **Classes begin at 0800 hours** unless stated otherwise by the course coordinator. Late entry to class will not be permitted unless notified earlier to the course coordinator for being late with genuine/appropriate reason.
