2. All interested participants **must enroll prior to the course commencement dates** stated above. The **course fee must be paid in full before attending the class**. 3. If you are enrolled for a certain date, you are **mandatorily required** to complete the course **within the dates**. If you **cannot attend** the course as per the specified date, you are required to **withdraw before the commencement of the course**.
