About Us

The National Trade Testing Scheme (NTTS) is the only trade skills assessment body in the country, managed by the National Training and Productivity Centre (NTPC) of the Fiji National University (FNU).

The scheme was set up in 1976 to upgrade the standard of skills in various trades through skills testing and certification, hence providing the required standard of manpower to industries in Fiji. Levels of testing under the scheme (and as required by the 1976 Fiji National Trade Testing Regulation) are:

Class III Assistant Tradesperson Level Class II Qualified Tradesperson Level Class I Supervisor Level

There are no minimal educational requirements for candidates, which means that candidates having some or no formal training are entitled to demonstrate their levels of skills against the established standards, provided that they have the necessary trade or industry experience and knowledge in the discipline.

Eligibility Criteria

There are two (2) sets of criteria, one for Electricians and the General one for all the other trades. Prospective candidates are advised to contact the Department for further clarification on equivalent eligibility and exemption criteria.

Nature of Tests and Result Determination

Trade Tests cover theoretical knowledge as well as practical demonstration of the trade, however, in the Class III category, candidates may opt between a written or an oral theoretical test.

Pass result and trade test certificate awarded:

Passed Practical test = 60% minimum marks obtained in the practical test.

Passed Theory Test = 50% minimum marks obtained in the theory test.

Partial - pass result:

Passed Practical test = 60% minimum marks obtained in the practical test.

Failed Theory Test = below 50% marks obtained in the theory test. Required to re-sit the theory test only.

Fail result:

Failed Practical test = below 60% marks obtained in the practical test. Required to repeat both the practical and theory tests.

Normal Test:

is conducted on the minimum number of candidates.

Special Test: candidates do not have to wait for the minimum number. All Special tests are conducted in the central division.

Applying for Trade Test

Participants are required to apply online through the FNU Website- https://crm-student.fnu.ac.fj New users need to create an account first. The following documents will be required to be uploaded:

- · 1 passport size photo
- · Birth Certificate
- · Joint Card/TIN Letter
- Certified true copy of business registration and/or business license –if self-employed
- Statutory Declaration signed by a Justice of Peace if the candidate is self-employed
- Principal's testimonial and/or high school result for candidates below the age of 21 years
- Job References(s) showing full-time experience (provide statutory declaration where references cannot be provided)
- If NTPC Student Logbook (1400 Hrs., signed & Stamped on every page) with letter of completion (Modular Program- Class III level only).

Candidates will be notified of the date, time and place of the trade test should your application be approved. Candidates whose application has not been successful will be notified accordingly.
