FNU academic wins prestigious Deans Award for Research Higher Degree Excellence at James Cook University

Dr Alvin Lal, Assistant Professor with the Department of Physics at Fiji National University's College of Engineering, Science and Technology, was recognised amongst the 133 higher research candidates competing for the prestigious Deans Award for Research Higher Degree Excellence at James Cook University (JCU) in Australia. Dr Lal's PhD thesis topic is "Groundwater modelling and management". Dr Lal published in Q1 and Q2 journals and secured several travel grants, which allowed him to participate in various conferences in Australia, Japan, USA, and Spain.

Certificate of participation in the online training on Soil Salinity Mapping, organised by the Pacific Soil Partnership

Dr Deeksha Krishna, Associate Dean Research with the College of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry participated in the online training on digital soil mapping organised by Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations-Global Soil Partnership.

The Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations-Global Soil Partnership (FAO-GSP) due to the COVID-19 emergency organised its training on digital soil mapping-towards the development of national soil salinity maps for Pacific countries from 4th May to 22nd May 2020 online. Through online video lecturing, virtual communication, and digital data transfer, the training had been successful with participants from 17 pacific countries. This workshop focused on the basics of Digital Soil Mapping (DSM), for example, mapping soil salinity indicators to strengthen the work on soil and for a sustainable soil management system.
