#### Sports Complex, Nasinu Campus

Construction Contract was signed with Fortech Construction Ltd for the much awaited Sports Complex project on 22nd January 2019 and actual works commenced on 02nd January 2019

The sports complex has an international size multipurpose court, cardio section, weights section, and multiple flexible spaces. The space will be used for wellness programmes for staff and students, and as well as a teaching facility for sport science programme. The multipurpose court will be able to host sports such as basketball, futsal, volley ball, net ball and badminton and has audience capacity of 230.

### Ground Breaking Ceremony for Veterinary Training Hospital

27th March 2019 marked a monumental occasion not only for the University but also for the country's agricultural industry when the Minister for Agriculture & Waterways, Honourable Dr. Mahendra Reddy officiated the Veterinary Hospital ground-breaking ceremony at FNU Koronivia Campus. This occasion was blessed by a traditional 'Yagona Vakaturaga' from the chiefly Navuso, Naitasiri province.

This project is fully funded by the Government of Fiji.



### Contract Signing for Solar PV Project at Nadi Campus

The Fiji National University (FNU) would like to generate 90 percent of its electricity through green initiatives in the next three years for Western Campuses. The contract signing for this project took place in Nadi campus with CBS Power Solutions Fiji Ltd, a Renewable Energy Contractor operating in the region.

This project is initiated by Division Capital Projects & Infrastructure, championed by the Director Mr. Chettiar and provides a 250 kilowatt solar photovoltaics (PV) plant with roof and ground mounted systems to generate clean energy catering for up to 80% of Campus' power demand. The project is expected to be completed this year.

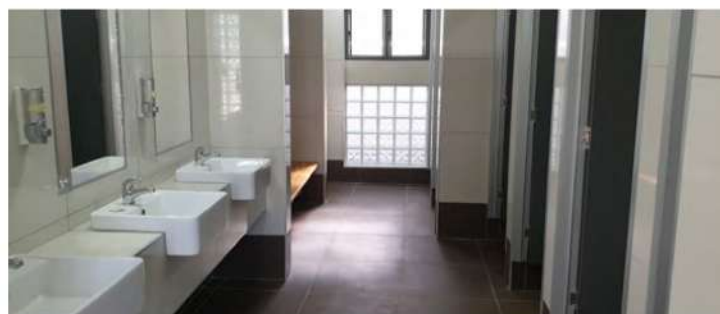


## Highlights
