## Overview

The Division of Capital Projects and Infrastructure (DCPI) is delighted to introduce 'Capital Projects and Infrastructure Quarterly Newsletter'.

DCPI was formed together with the Division of Estates and Facilities (DEF) last year as a result of decentralization of functions from the former Division of Properties and Facilities (DPF). The DCPI team works closely with external consultants, advisers, statutory authorities, and specialist internal

departments on all FNU capital infrastructure projects. The Division is working towards providing sustainable infrastructure that supports the university's core objectives of the Strategic Plan.

Currently, DCPI is actively accommodating a total of 23 projects. 11 of these projects are currently in the construction phase, 3 are in the tender phase while 9 projects are currently in design phase.

## Project of the Quarter – College of Business, Hospitality, and Tourism Studies Complex



The College of Business, Hospitality, and Tourism Studies (CBHTS) Complex is earmarked to be built on Nasinu Campus.

This project has been in the planning stages for some time now and has received funding from government to progress the project further.

The complex is a four-storey building with two wings. One wing will be dedicated to a lecture theatre, while the other wing will have 3 levels. This building makes provision for state-of-the-art teaching and learning facilities.

The ground floor will have a dedicated Student Services Centre. The Centre will be a one-stop-shop for students to meet their academic requirements. There will also be a Café located in this complex.

The building is disability friendly as well, as part of the universities goal to increase disability friendliness on its campuses.

The project is currently on tender for construction, which will close on Monday 20 August, 2018.

While the division continues to work on major multi-million dollar projects, it also undertakes projects which are completely designed and managed internally.

## Tuisuva Dental Clinic at College of Medicine, Nursing and Health Sciences, Pasifika Campus

This state-of-the-art Dental clinic was partially funded by the Government of Fiji and FNU to make provision of 28 dental chairs for teaching purposes. The total cost of this project was approximately \$3.8million. The facility also has dental X-ray and OPG machines.



## Construction of Piggery shed at Koronivia Campus

This project, located at the Livestock Farm at Koronivia will offer students enrolled in the Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Science to undertake practical experience. This facility has the capacity to house 5 soars and 1 boar and it also has 3 weaner pans.



## Study Space at Nasinu Campus

The Study Bure named 'BUTURARA' provides space for informal study area, also known as learning commons internationally. This space has become popular spot for students at Nasinu Campus since its opening in mid-May this year.
