### Engineering Research & Development Centre

The College of Engineering, Science and Technology has embarked to attain Engineering New Zealand accreditation for its Bachelor in Engineering Programs.

The new Engineering Research & Development Centre will accommodate an enclosed lab, open lab and research lab. The enclosed lab is air conditioned to cater for sophisticated equipment.

There are two interactive classrooms which has access to TVs at each station. This will enable the instructor to project information or share screen on the respective tables. The rooms are flexible to allow movement of tables and chairs based on the requirement of the class.

The facility will have open learning spaces to engage students before and after their classes.

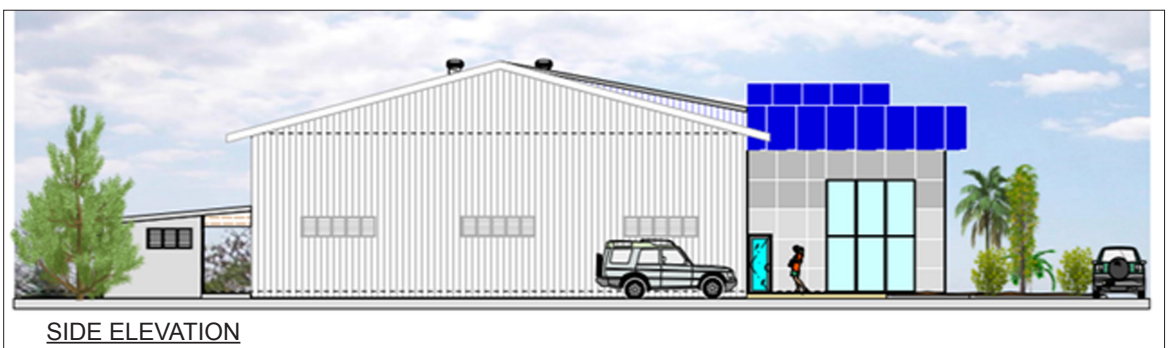
There are three discussion rooms for group activities and consultations.

The technical staff has spaces allocated to administer the facility with a provision of reception as well.

Students and staff will have access to common facilities such as kitchenette, washroom and change room.

This state-of- art facility will be the first of its kind in Fiji, which will be accessible by students with special needs.

The project has commenced as of 17th of December 2018 and expected to be completed by August 2019.

### Construction Contract Signing for College of Business, Hospitality, and Tourism Studies Complex, Nasinu Campus

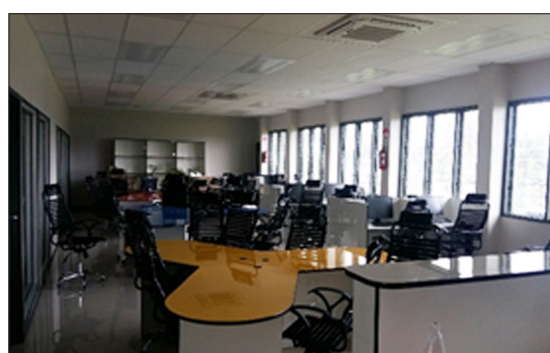
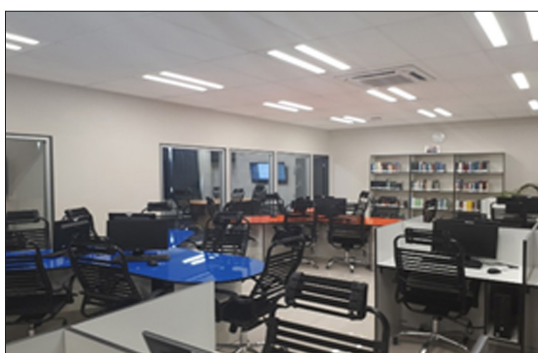
The construction contract signing event was marked by the presence of the Honourable Minister of Education, Heritage and Arts. Moreover, traditional 'sevusevu' was presented to the Tui Kalabu for the Vanua's blessing.

The contract was signed with Cope Construction Ltd. Construction of a four storey building has commenced at the Nasinu Campus as of 2nd of December 2019. The Fiji Government has provided funding for the project and FNU is grateful for the continuous support.



### Extension to Library at Koroniva Campus

The College of Agriculture, Fisheries & Forestry Library expansion was successfully completed. Learning Commons was created to encourage collaborative learning with the provision of interactive technology. There are 3 discussion rooms and each has provision of smart TVs and Wifi connectivity.
