

World Book and Copyright Day

World Book and Copyright Day is celebrated all over the world to recognize the power of books, promote and protect intellectual property through copyright. Every year World Book and Copyright Day is celebrated on 23rd April. The United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization's (UNESCO) General Conference chose this date to pay tribute to books, the authors who wrote them and protect their intellectual property through copyright. FNU Library had as well planned to celebrate the event on Friday 23rd April

2021, unfortunately the event was cancelled due to Fijian Government's statement with regards to restrictions on gathering. Nevertheless, through this newsletter, FNU library shares with you all, the essence of books in our lives.

For decades, books have been used in many activities, including research, non-research studies, leisure and has built a foundation towards development of other areas such as scholarly collections. As said by Audrey Azoulay, Director-General of UNESCO, on the occasion of World Book and Copyright Day 2020 "Books have the unique ability both to entertain and to teach. They are at once a means of exploring realms beyond our personal experience through exposure to different authors, universes and cultures, and a means of accessing the deepest recesses of our inner selves".
