Screen time has been linked to a number of pediatrics health determinants and outcomes including higher risk of obesity, poor metabolic profile, poor fitness later in life, violent and aggressive behavior, poor cognitive development (eg poor short term memory skills, poor reading, and language and mathematics development) and adverse psychosocial health.
