Biography

Dr Satish Chand is an Assistant Professor in Education at the College of Humanities, Education & Law, Fiji National University.

He obtained his PhD in Education from the University of the South Pacific in 2021. With 18 years of experience in primary education, he transitioned to higher education in 2008 as a Lecturer at Lautoka Teachers College before joining Fiji National University in 2010.

Throughout his academic career, Dr Chand has held several leadership roles, including Head of Department (Primary and Secondary), Head of School (Education), and currently serves as Acting Associate Dean Learning and Teaching. He is actively engaged in educational research and has published extensively in reputable international journals, while also serving as a reviewer for several scholarly publications. In addition, he has mentored postgraduate students and academic staff in research and publication, and has served as an examiner and reviewer for Master's and PhD theses both locally and internationally.
