FNU, Fiji TV take Calcul8 to new level

Fiji National University and Fiji Television Limited have partnered for a second year to bring mathematics television quiz *Calcul8* on air.

Speaking at the signing yesterday, Fiji Television Limited group chief executive officer Tarun Patel said the competition had taken on another dimension with the inclusion of secondary students.

Last year's competition only had primary school students.

"We are proud to be associated with FNU for a very educational program," he said.

Mr Patel said it was an exciting time for Fiji TV as well their sponsors.

Acting Dean of FNU's College of Engineering, Science and Technology, Mr Josua Mataika said it was a privilege for FNU to be partnering with Fiji TV for such a program.
