Speaker: Nicholas Kralev: Author, Journalist and Entrepreneur

FNU Department of Media and Journalism in partnership with the American Embassy is inviting you to a public lecture at the Lecture theatre 1 at the Unistudio Raiwai Campus on the 31st of March from 1-2pm

The guest speaker is author, journalist and entrepreneur Mr Nicholas Kralev from America. He will be talking on "American Diplomacy vs Foreign policy". His areas of expertise are international diplomacy, global aviation and communications. As a former Financial Times and Washington Times correspondent, he has travelled around the world with four U.S, secretaries of state- Hillary Clinton, Condoleeza Rice, Colin Powell and Madeleine Albright. He has flown over 2 million miles and visited 94 countries.

Kralev will discuss how the work of American diplomats affects the daily lives of millions of people around the world and how U.S. diplomacy has changed since 9/11. Kralev has been given unprecedented access to the inner sanctum of American diplomacy in Washington and around the world over several years. He will also talk about his recent book, "America's Other Army", which is based on his visits to more than 50 embassies and interviews with 600 career diplomats, as well as Hillary Clinton, Condoleeza Rice, Collin Powell and Madeleine Albright. For a decade, Kralev travelled with these U.S. secretaries of state to over 80 countries as a newspaper correspondent.
