FCDCL Chief Executive Officer, Mr Sachida Nand said the partnership is the beginning for a lot to come for the dairy industry.

"The MoU gives us a lot of opportunities in cross-collaboration with one of the best institutes here which is more into agriculture and other activities that gives us the opportunity to tap into each other's resources in getting the dairy industry activities beyond what we are currently doing," said Mr Nand.

Dean of CAFF, Professor Paras Nath said such agreement between an educational institute and the dairy company is a first for Fiji.
