

## New FNU students urged to complete enrolment process quickly to avoid last minute rush

Less than two-weeks remain before the commencement of Semester One 2019 and the Fiji National University (FNU) is urging all new students to enrol into the course units for programmes they intend to pursue as soon as they receive Offer Letters.

FNU's Director Marketing and Communications Jenies Mudiliar said students need to be aware that to become a confirmed University student, they need to accept the offer and register for courses according to the programme structure.

"We have noted in the past that some students unfortunately complete their enrollments late as they are under the impression that once they have received their Offer Letters they are automatically enrolled into the programme of study they intend to pursue. Students however need to complete the enrollment process which is provided in the Offer Letter to confirm their place in the University," said Mudiliar.

"So to avoid the last minute rush, or missing out on the Orientation, we are requesting all students who have received their Offer Letters from FNU to visit our main campuses to complete their enrollment process."

"For those students who have sent in their applications and are awaiting Offer Letters we request these students to contact the Student Academic Services in Nasinu on 3394000 or send an email to [admission@fnu.ac.fj](mailto:admission@fnu.ac.fj) so they can be assisted accordingly," Mudiliar added.

The Director also encouraged all new students to take note of the dates for the 2019 Orientation Week and attend this important event. The Orientation Week will be held at FNU Campuses around the country.

"Attending the Orientation Week will help students prepare for tertiary studies. Students will receive important information about the different Colleges, Support Services, Programme and Course advice as well as Academic Skills Development," she said.
